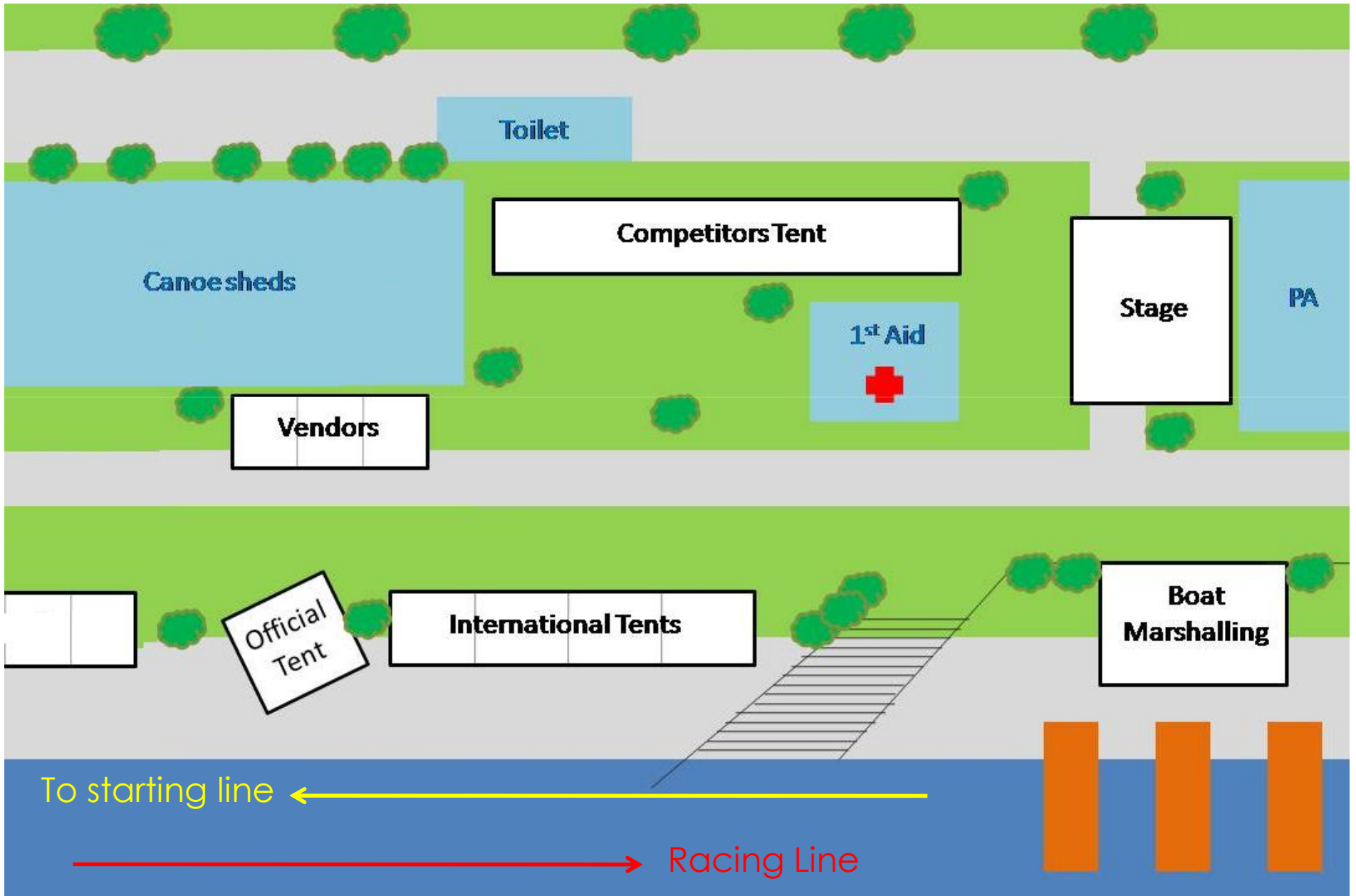

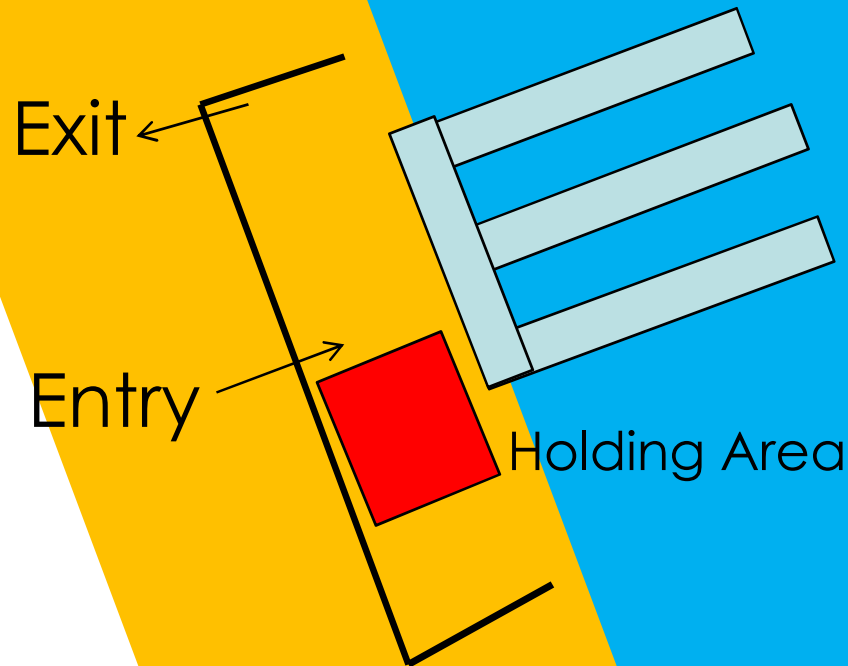
Race Site Layout

BEDOK RESERVOIR PARK



Marshalling Area / Marshalling Sequence

- Report 30mins before allocated time
- Make sure every paddler wears the ID Tags
- Enter Marshalling area together with a completed Crew List
- Once entered Holding Area, Team Captain to collect ID tags before paddlers enters boat.
- Team Captains are supposed to hold on to tags until team returns from race.
- A random check of the team may be done even when team returns from race

False Start

- Crew starts immediately after the word “Attention” and before the word “GO”
- Up to 2 seconds penalty

Jump Start

- Crew has anticipated the word before the word “GO”
- Between 2 – 5 seconds penalty

Protest & Appeals

- All **Protests** shall be made in writing by the Team Manager to the Race Director.
- Protest must be addressed to the Board of Jury within 15 minutes of the end of the race.
- A protest shall be accompanied by a fee of **\$\$150.00** which is refundable if the protest is upheld.
- Only in exceptional circumstances will the Board of Jury take longer than 30 minutes to consider any one protest.
- Races may be held back when considering a protest.



Protest & Appeals

-In the event of a team being disqualified for infringement of the Racing Rules and Regulations by the Competition Committee, and the team intends to file an enquiry, that is called an **Appeal**.

-An appeal against a decision of the Competition Committee shall be addressed to the Chairman of the Jury and handed in no later than 20 minutes after the Team Manager has acknowledged receipt(s) of the Competition Committee's decision of any disqualification.

-An appeal shall be accompanied by a fee of **S\$250.00** which is refundable if the appeal is successful.

-The discussion of the appeal by the Jury of Appeal will not take more than 30 minutes.

-The Organiser at its discretion will appoint competent persons for the Jury of Appeal. The decision of the Jury of Appeal is final
